

How do I search for the classification of a medicine in a particular country?

Answer:

If you know the ATC or the INN of the active ingredient you are looking for, you should select the corresponding item in the appropriate search bar (i.e. 'Select ATC' or 'Select INN'), then choose the country of interest in 'Select Country' and click 'Search'. You can either scroll down the list of countries or type the first few characters to quickly find the country you are looking for.

If you wish to have an overview of the classification status of a medicine in the countries that contribute to the work of the Committee of Experts CD-P-PH/PHO, select the ATC code or INN of the active ingredient in the appropriate search bar ('Filters' section) and select the checkbox next to 'National Data'.

If you do not know the ATC code or the INN of the active ingredient you are looking for, you can find them in the [ATC/DDD Index](#).
