

How can I find out why revisions were made to the European Pharmacopoeia?



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Answer:

Major revisions are published in Pharmeuropa with a “NOTE...” explaining the reasons for the changes. After publication, the information is included in the ‘History’ section in the text entry in the [Knowledge Database](#). Minor revisions are not published in Pharmeuropa but include a NOTE that is transferred to the ‘History’ section of the text entry, after publication.
